

BY-LAW No. 33-2

**A BY-LAW IN AMENDMENT OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF
THE VILLAGE OF SALISBURY BY-LAW 33-1,
A BY-LAW RESPECTING INSTALLATION OF CROSSWAYS**

The Council of the Municipality of the Village of Salisbury hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) Standards acceptable for the installation of crossways:
All pipe shall have a minimum diameter of 15" (375mm) and shall be 24' (7.3m) in length, consisting of:
 - (a) either three sections of reinforced concrete pipe 8' (2.5m) in length, with joints wrapped with filter fabric;
 - (b) a single pipe of corrugated, round, 16 gauge, double zinc dipped galvanized steel;
 - (c) a single pipe of Polyethylene high density double walled with smooth interior surface and a minimum ring stiffness of 320 kPa, meeting the requirement of CAN/CSA B182.6, and commonly referred to as 'Transportation Grade' and not 'Forestry Grade'.
- 2) The crossway must be inspected and passed, before being covered, by the Village Manager of Works and following this approval the Village will be responsible for future maintenance;
- 3) All new installations of crossways shall be the financial responsibility of the lot owner or developer;
- 4) The Municipality has agreed that any variation in crossway size or length will be the decision of the Village Manager of Works;
- 5) Subject to section 4, any such variation will not be permitted to cause the total structure length to exceed 40% of the lot frontage or 12.6 meters, whichever occurs first, and furthermore, that the property owner, and any subsequent property owner, shall assume full responsibility for the entire crossway.

By-Law No. 33-1 is hereby repealed.
