SPECIAL MEETING

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

It was moved by Councillor Thorne and seconded by Councillor O'Blenis that '*The Agenda be approved.*' MOTION CARRIED

2022 UTILITY OPERATING FUND MOTIONS

Set Sewer Rate – It was moved by Councillor Gallant and seconded by Councillor Thorne that '*The Village of Salisbury set the annual Wastewater Disposal Rate at \$325 per unit for the year 2022.*' MOTION CARRIED

Approval of Budget – It was moved by Councillor Gallant and seconded by Councillor Thorne that '*This is to certify that on the 15th day of November, 2021 the Council of the local government of Village of Salisbury RESOLVED that pursuant to subsection 117(4) of the Local Governance Act, the total budget for the Wastewater Disposal utility for the ensuing year would consist of total revenues of \$488,893 and total expenditures of \$488,893. Adopted this 15th day of November, 2021 by the Council of the local government of Village of Salisbury.*' MOTION CARRIED

2022 GENERAL OPERATING FUND MOTION

Approval of Budget and Set Tax Rate – It was moved by Councillor Colwell and seconded by Councillor O'Blenis that '*This is to certify that on the 15th day of November, 2021 the Council of the local government of Village of Salisbury RESOLVED that the sum of \$2,590,847 be the total operating budget of the local government, that the sum of \$2,082,922 be the Warrant of the local government for the ensuing year, and that the tax rate for the local government be: \$1.0442. The Council orders and directs the levying by the Minister of Environment and Local Government of said amount on real property liable to taxation under the Assessment Act within the local government of: Village of Salisbury. Adopted this 15th day of November, 2021 by the Council of the local government of Village of Salisbury.*' MOTION CARRIED

Signed and sealed budget documents to be delivered via courier to the New Brunswick Department of Environment and Local Government for its approval.
