1. SHOW DATE IS FRIDAY, AUGUST 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
2. THE EXHIBIT HALL WILL BE OPEN TO EXHIBITORS FOR PLACING EXHIBITS FROM 9:00 AM UNTIL **2:00 PM** FRIDAY, AT WHICH TIME ALL EXHIBITORS MUST LEAVE THE HALL. JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 2:30 PM. **ALL EXHIBITS MUST REMAIN ON DISPLAY UNTIL AFTER 8:00 PM FRIDAY.**
3. THE EXHIBIT HALL WILL BE OPEN FOR GENERAL VIEWING FROM 5:00 PM UNTIL 8:00 PM FRIDAY.
4. ALL FLOWERS AND VEGETABLES MUST HAVE BEEN GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR. WORK FINISHED IN PAST FAIR YEAR ONLY MAY BE ENTERED.
5. ALL EXHIBITORS MAY ENTER IN ALL OR ANY SECTION AND CLASS. BUT ONLY ONE EXHIBIT FOR EACH EXHIBITOR IN EACH CLASS.
6. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE TAGGED AND LABELLED FOR EXHIBITION WHEN ENTERED. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF PRIZE MONEY SHOULD EXHIBIT BE A WINNER. ENTRY TAGS AND EXTRA ENTRY FORMS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE VILLAGE OFFICE IN AUGUST AND AT THE EXHIBIT HALL ON THE FRIDAY MORNING OF THE SHOW.
7. ALL ENTRY FORMS TO BE COMPLETED BY THE EXHIBITOR. PLEASE LIST ENTRIES ON ENTRY FORM PROVIDED IN THE ORDER THAT THEY APPEAR IN THE BOOK. **FAILURE TO PROPERLY COMPLETE FORM WILL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF PRIZE MONEY.**
8. IF THERE IS ONLY ONE ENTRY IN A CLASS AND THE JUDGES DO NOT CONSIDER IT WORTHY OF FIRST PRIZE IT MAY BE GIVEN SECOND OR THIRD IF DEEMED WORTHY.
9. PRIZE MONEY IS FIRST \$3.00, SECOND \$2.00, THIRD \$1.00 EXCEPT FOR SPECIAL PRIZES. PRIZE MONEY WILL BE GIVEN OUT ON FRIDAY NIGHT AT 8:00 PM IF AT ALL POSSIBLE. PRIZE MONEY THAT HAS NOT BEEN PICKED UP WILL GO TOWARD NEXT YEAR'S COMMUNITY DAYS EVENTS.
10. CLASSES ARE OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
11. PROFESSIONAL PERSONS OR FIRMS THAT MAKE A MONETARY GAIN FROM FLOWERS, VEGETABLES, BAKING, AND/OR CRAFTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO COMPETE.

12. WHILE ALL DUE CARE AND ATTENTION IS TAKEN, THE SHOW COMMITTEE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE TO THE EXHIBITS OR PERSONAL PROPERTY.
