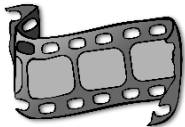

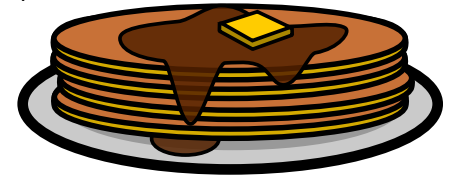
- 10-2pm** **Seniors Day** @ Legion - Open to all seniors. Soup, sandwiches & cake, games and fun. (FREE)

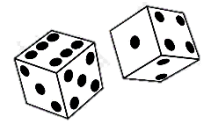
