In the event of a disaster or emergency, the Village of Salisbury and the New Brunswick Emergency Measures Organization encourages all of us to be prepared as best as we can to be able to manage on our own for at least 72 hours. In addition to emergency kits, all homes should have an emergency plan. The plan should include elements such as: emergency exits, gathering locations, a list of contact information, a plan for your pets, and any specific health needs.
